Sampling Method	<p>Landline: Registered Oklahoma voters were selected randomly and surveyed on the evening of August 2nd, 2015 on their landline telephone using an interactive voice response system.</p> <p>Mobile: Registered Oklahoma voters unable to be reached by landline were surveyed using their mobile device on August 2nd and 3rd, 2015.</p>
Weighting	<p>Only respondents determined likely to vote in the 2016 Republican presidential primary were included in the survey.</p> <p>The poll was weighted for age, race, and gender according to 2012 presidential primary voter statistics.</p>
Total Number of Respondents	402 (weighted)
Margin of Error	±4.8% (95% confidence)
