Target Population	Likely 2016 General election voters; Georgia
Sampling Method	<p>Blended sample; mixed mode:</p> <p>Likely voters were selected from a list of registered Georgia voters. Only voters determined likely to vote in the 2016 general election were included in the sample.</p> <p>Landline: registered voters were contacted on the evening of October 20th, 2016 using an interactive voice response system.</p> <p>Mobile: registered voters were contacted on October 20th, 2016 on their mobile devices. Respondents answered an identical survey in visual form.</p>
Weighting	The survey was weighted for age, race, gender, party-within-age, party affiliation, and region using propensity scores. Weighting benchmarks were determined using historical turnout data and internal projections.
