Sponsor(s)	Fox 5 Atlanta
Target Population	Likely and early 2016 General election voters; Georgia
Sampling Method	Blended sample; mixed mode: Likely voters were selected from a list of registered Georgia voters. Only voters determined likely to vote or who have voted early/absentee in the 2016 general election were included in the sample. Landline: registered voters were contacted on the evenings of November 2 nd and 3 rd , 2016 using an interactive voice response system. Mobile: registered voters were contacted on the evenings of November 2 nd and 3 rd , 2016 on their mobile devices. Respondents answered an identical survey in visual form.
Weighting	The survey was weighted for age, race, gender, party-within-age, party affiliation, and region using propensity scores. Weighting benchmarks were determined using past voter turnout figures and internal projections.
