Target Population	Likely voters; Georgia CD6 special election
Sampling Method	<p>Blended sample; mixed mode</p> <p>Likely voters were selected from a prescreened list of registered Georgia voters. Only voters determined likely to vote in the special election were selected to participate in the survey.</p> <p>Landline: selected voters were contacted on March 22nd and 23rd 2017 using an interactive voice response system.</p> <p>Mobile: selected voters were contacted on March 22nd and 23rd 2017 on their mobile devices. Respondents answered an identical survey in visual form.</p>
Weighting	<p>The survey was weighted for age, race, gender, and party identification using propensity scores. Weighting benchmarks were determined using past voter turnout figures and internal projections.</p> <p>For runoff questions, the weighting scheme was altered to reflect the likely voter demographic profile of runoff voters. These questions are marked with an asterisk (*).</p>
